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## Applications Open for 2025 Regular Admissions

- Sign up for the common application service in advance and review the common application process for regular admissions.
- A university admissions counseling center is available to assist students with their university admissions applications.

- Applications for regular admission to universities in 2025 will begin on December 31, 2024. To prepare for the application process, the Korean Council for University Education (KCUE) recommends that students sign up for the **common application service\*** and **complete the common application form in advance.**

\* Common application service: Students can apply for admission to multiple universities simply by completing a common application form.

- Four-year universities, in three admission groups, will accept applications **from Tuesday, December 31, 2024, through Friday, January 3, 2025.** Two-year colleges will do so from **Tuesday, December 31, 2024 through Tuesday, January 14, 2025.**
- Students can **register for the common application service** and check to see **if they have already completed the common**

**application form before regular admissions applications open.**

- If you have already **signed up for the service and completed a common application for early admissions, you can reuse it.** Students who have not applied for early admission will need to **register for the service and complete the application form first.**
- Register with one of the application service agencies (Uway Apply or Jinhak Apply) and you can apply to all universities that accept applications through the agency of your choice.

□ **The common application process works in the following way:**

**1 Sign up for the service to submit a common application.**

- Visit one of the application service agencies' website (Uway Apply or Jinhak Apply) and **register as a member.**
- Make sure that **you can easily access the website of the agency of your choice** on your computer.

※ If you experience errors or challenges in accessing the agency website, contact the agency call center (Uway Apply: 1588-8988, Jinhak Apply: 1544-7715).

- Recommended environment: Chrome or Microsoft Edge browser on Windows.

**2 Fill out the common application form**

- Use your membership details to log in to the agency website and fill out the common application form.
- In the common application form, enter your name, Resident Registration Number, address, contact number, account information for refund, and school attended.

※ When entering a refund account, be sure to enter a valid account

number that will remain active and open at the time of the university's refund, if any (double check account availability if it is a youth-only account).

- Once you have completed the common application form, you can use it to apply to all the universities you wish, or modify it as needed for your applications.
  - The common application form can be “exported” and “imported” between the application service agencies.
  - If you have modified your common application form, make sure to click on the “Export” button to apply your changes to the application form stored at the other agency.
    - ※ Example: You log in to the Uway Apply service and fill out a common application form. And you notice that a university you want to apply to only accepts applications from Jinhak Apply. In this case, you can export your application from Uway Apply and import it to Jinhak Apply to submit your pre-filled application.
  - For a streamlined application experience, it is recommended to use the Chrome or Microsoft Edge browser on a Windows PC.

### **③ Pay application fees**

- Select one or more universities to apply to. Review all of the information on your common application form and make changes as needed. Fill in additional university-specific fields, such as specific majors at the university of your choice and a profile photo. Save your application.
  - You can pay the application fees individually or all at once (for each agency).
- KCUE urged students to sign up for the service and fill out the common application form so they are ready to submit**

**their applications when regular admissions applications open.**

- In particular, the council recommends that **students double-check if they can easily access these agencies' websites from their computers, sign up for the service, and complete the common application form.**
- The user's computer environment, especially the **Internet browser, is frequently updated.** Students should verify in advance that **the common application service system is working properly** from their computer environment.
- If you are using a shared or public computer, it is recommended that you take extra care and take all available precautions to ensure that you do not experience any program errors or the like during the application process.
- Meanwhile, KCUE provides application guides for students on its **YouTube channel @kcue-adagatv** to help them easily understand how the application process works. In addition, the **university information portal "Adiga" (adiga.kr)** is a single platform for students to find **university-specific details** about regular admissions for 2025.
- The **university admissions information portal Adiga (adiga.kr)** provides the **previous year's admissions results and grade calculation services** to help students gauge the likelihood of success in their applications. It also provides **online advice** to help them find answers to their questions and search for university admissions information through the **Adiga TV**

## **YouTube channel.**

- "Students can rely on grading information from the **university admissions information portal (adiga.kr)** and their academic records to design their higher education plans. They can consult **career and academic counselors at their school**, call the **KCUE call center (1600-1615)** or use **online services**," said a KCUE official.
  
- The KCUE Admissions Counseling Center announced that it will provide **intensive counseling** to help students applying to universities to be better prepared for regular admissions applications for 2025, which will open on December 31.
  
- The university admission counseling team, consisting of 423 high school teachers, will provide accurate advice based on university-specific selection information and the previous year's selection results to alleviate the concerns of students and their parents.
  
- The intensive counseling service will be available free of charge from December 23 to January 3, 2025. The service hours are from 9:00 to 22:00 and can be accessed by phone (1600-1615) or online (adiga.kr).
